Official Meeting Minutes

DISTRICT MEETING ON; June 05, 2009
Meeting came to order at: 7:00pm

Moment of Silence for Military Personnel
Minutes read and accepted.
Payment and Payroll minutes read and accepted.

At 7:10p.m. Commissioner Bob Hutchinson closed the District meeting for a private session.
The District meeting was reopened by Bob Hutchinson at 7:20p.m.

The District was awarded a \$4500.00 grant for labor to install security fencing around the wells. Bob Hutchinson has applied for grants for generators as well. Although \$8500.00 for the generators was approved at this year's annual meeting it's worth trying for grant money to save the District residents from having to pay for them. Bob let everyone know the entryway roof was finally put on the treatment center. Resident Wayne Boutin did the work. Linda Walker asked how he got the job. Bob replied bids went out for this job. It was suggested local residents be considered for any district work that needs to be done in the future. Bob agreed.

Bob Burton has been doing a lot of research on windmill and solar power. It was suggested as alternative power for the district. The startup cost would be about \$7500.00. The district pays an estimated \$1300.00 a month in electric to run the wells so the windmills and solar panels would pay for themselves in a short period of time. . Bob asked if anyone would like to volunteer to organize a committee. Web designer David Stefanelli said he would put all the information on the ELVD website once he's given all the details. This will have to be a Warrant Article at next year's annual meeting.

Bob said some residents in the Turtle Bridge area of the District are thinking about organizing pot luck; meet your neighbors type of event. The weekend after the Balloon Fest was the suggested time. Eastman Park would be the location. A District Yard Sale was also suggested by a couple of residents. That event has yet to be decided upon.

Linda Walker asked about the status of the destruction of the District beaches. A discussion followed including Bob saying a teenage boy was caught destroying a portable toilet. The police were called and his parents were contacted. Community Service was the punishment. It was also suggested by several residents that stricter punishments be given in the future.

Bob issued the first \$125.00 water ban fine.

Bob Hutchinson motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:50p.m. Commissioner Troy Cornock seconded.
