

July 5, 2017 Workshop Meeting Minutes

The Workshop was called to order at 6:07 p.m.

BOC's were questioning an invoice from Skippy Edwards but after speaking with Skippy and looking over contract, as well as past invoices the invoice will be paid. Residents were able to ask Skippy questions and express concerns to him about the roads. Skippy has provided his cell phone number to Keith Huber, Commissioner to be able to have better communication. Keith Huber, Commissioner has asked residents to please write an email to info@elvdnh.com for any concerns, complaints, or questions for Skippy Edwards and he will forward them to Skippy.

Motion was made to accept a set of horseshoes from Frank and Margaret Riley, seconded, and approved.

Diane Cunningham, Commissioner states that a letter needs to be written to the town to be able to collect the funds that were voted on through the warrant articles to put into the CIP account.

BOC's state the Hillsboro Fire Department will be joining ELVD's Commissioner Monthly Meeting next week to speak with residents.

BOC's state that Northpoint has a plan for phase two for the Hummingbird/Hemlock intersection and are just waiting to hear back from them. BOC's will keep residents updated.

Diane Cunningham, Commissioner thanked residents for their conservation of water, as the water tank is holding steady. Keith Huber, Commissioner presented quotes for the water ban signs and decision will be made at the monthly commissioner meeting next week.

BOC's discussed a resident's letter asking about an old water line that is still in place. Keith Huber, Commissioner will discuss with WSO and get back to resident to investigate the situation more.

Keith Huber, Commissioner discussed ATV use with Chief O'Rourke from HPD and states that it is not ELVD responsibility to notify anyone of any town or state ordinance. ELVD responsibilities are water, beaches and roads. Chief O'Rourke and BOC's ask residents to call the Hillsboro Police Department with any complaints of ATV use in the district.

Diane Cunningham, Commissioner and Keith Huber, Commissioner coded the invoices/bills for the general and water account for the month.

Brett Taber, resident checked on prices for the porta potty's to find the best deal. Brett Taber, resident states that Guardian Septic charges \$101 a month per unit, so district will have a savings there. Commissioners thanked Brett Taber, resident for helping with this.

Discussion was had about the town owned roads and whether materials are being used twice (from Skippy Edwards and Hillsboro Town) to maintain. Keith Huber, Commissioner will look into this and get back to residents with results.
