Official Meeting Minutes

DISTRICT MEETING ON; July 07, 2011

Meeting came to order at: 7:00pm.

Moment of Silence

Minutes and Payroll and Payment Manifest read and accepted

Present: Commissioners Bob Hutchinson and John Dahood, District Administrator Jim Coffey and resident George Croteau.

Commissioner Bob Hutchinson opened the meeting discussing the recent work done on the Hummingbird and Meeting House wells. Mike Keister was paid \$13,300.00 for the work on the Meeting House well. The well had been producing eleven gallons per minute and it is now producing thirty four gallons per minute. John Plummer was paid \$4567.00 for his work on the Hummingbird well. The well had been producing thirteen gallons per minute and is now producing forty gallons per minute. Bob said all the wells are producing 153 gallons per minute total. A project in the future would be to deepen the Mary Rowe well.

Administrator Jim Coffey discussed the engineering contract proposal from DuBois and King. The first contract came in at \$41,500.00 for engineering and overseeing the Hummingbird Bridge project. Jim said a motion would have to be made and the Commissioners would have to accept it. Commissioner Bob Hutchinson made a motion to accept the DuBois and King contract. Commissioner John Dahood seconded the motion. All in favor. As always, Jim said all information is always available to all residents interested. George Croteau asked if the bridge will be started in September as planned. Bob Hutchinson said it should start on time. He said he would like to send out a mass email and put an article in the paper letting residents know of the start dates and timelines. He said all docks will have to be brought in prior to start time.

Resident George Croteau asked if there could be a state ban on gas powered boats in Emerald Lake. Jim Coffey said you would be hard pressed to get that to pass. Bob Hutchinson agreed that probably would never pass but did add you can't go faster than 10mph on the lake. The general consensus was that nobody seems to disobey this rule.

Bob Hutchinson said on July 14th and August 8th DES will be out to test the lake water. He said this is routine, it's done every summer.

A general discussion regarding the Gould Pond Bridge closed the meeting. Alternate routes into the District were possibly entering Ellen Brook Rd. and coming out on Melody Lane. This was assuming the road would be closed during the reconstruction. Jim suggested that Bob go down to the town offices and view the plans to give people a better idea of what's planned.

At 8:15pm Commissioner Bob Hutchinson motioned to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner John Dahood seconded the motion.
